DESCRIPTION	CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R34; A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND MANAGE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOERNE AND FOUR B PAVING, INC. FOR ANNUAL PAVEMENT CRACK SEALING.
STAFF'S RECOMMENDED ACTION (be specific)	Approve Resolution No. 2019-R34; Entering into an agreement with Four B Paving, Inc. for annual pavement crack sealing not to exceed \$45,000.00.

SUMMARY	<p>The Street Department budgets funds annually for various street maintenance items. This \$45,000 is budgeted for preventative maintenance to crack seal designated streets. Crack sealing streets involves routing out each crack, blowing it clean with compressed air, and then sealing the crack with a hot pour sealant. This material is then squeegeed in narrow bands along the crack to insure a proper seal. Streets are evaluated by staff and then prioritized based on need. Considering the contracted price staff estimates the first 8 streets on the priority list should be completed for sure and the remaining will be done if materials are still available.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Bentwood Dr. 2. Deer Hollow 3. Deer Creek 4. Terrace Dr. 5. Vista Verde Dr. 6. Lauren Lane 7. Ebner 8. Parkplace 9. Creek Side 10. Chappareal Creek 11. City Park Road <p>*This is an estimate and the final project could result in fewer or even a greater number of streets getting done.</p> <p>Staff solicited quotes for the project and received two qualified bids. A bid of \$3.00 per pound from TRC Paving and \$2.25 per pound from 4 B Paving. As the lowest qualified bidder staff recommends that 4B Paving is awarded the contract for crack sealing materials and labor.</p>
