CONTACT PERSON SUMMARY	Danny Zincke, Community Services Director Each year the Streets Department budgets funds for normal
	scheduled maintenance including the seal coating of streets. This process involves cleaning the street to be coated prior to the application of the asphalt emulsion and then topped with Grade 5 Trap rock. This process helps increase the life of the road by helping keep water from penetrating into the road subsurface. Staff evaluates and prioritizes streets to be seal coated each year. This year staff plans to seal coat the following streets: Esser from River Road to Blanco, Rosewood from Esser to Main St. and Graham St. from Fredric Creek to School St. Staff received one qualified bid from Vulcan Materials for \$40.85 per ton for Grade 5 Trap Rock. This material is used to seal coat select streets. Due to the transport distance of other suppliers it is typical to only get one or two interested vendors. Due to the way this material is delivered it often leads to run overs and staff recommends approving a price not to exceed \$18,500 to avoid having to bring any minor run overs back to City Council for payment.
