<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	RECEIVE BIDS AND AWARD CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE NORTHBOUND OLD SAN ANTONIO ROAD RIGHT TURN LANE AT HERFF ROAD AND CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R53; A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND MANAGE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOERNE AND _____ FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE NORTHBOUND OLD SAN ANTONIO ROAD RIGHT TURN LANE AT HERFF ROAD.
<b>STAFF'S RECOMMENDED ACTION (be specific)</b>	Receive bids and Approve Resolution No. 2019-R53; awarding the construction project to add a right turn lane on northbound Old San Antonio Road at Herff Road to Lone Star Site Work in an amount not to exceed \$79,833.95.

<b>SUMMARY</b>	<p>Herff Road between Main Street and River Road in its current configuration was recently constructed by Kendall County. It functions very well as a safe relief route for traffic needing simplified access to IH-10 and Main Street from north and east of the City. The new roadway is a divided four-lane section with turn lanes in the median islands at appropriate locations. At the intersection with Old San Antonio Road, the signalized intersection design facilitates widening of the existing two-lane roadway. But, no other improvements were made to Old San Antonio Road itself.</p> <p>It has been observed from traffic operations that there is an immediate need for adding a right-turn lane on northbound Old San Antonio Road at Herff. A significant volume of traffic desires to proceed eastbound but is often blocked from doing so by traffic that is stopped waiting to turn left at that signal. The need for this improvement is more readily apparent by the worn path of vehicles that have wandered off the roadway at the intersection to make this right turn. Thus, the project to pave an additional northbound lane and make the appropriate signage and striping improvements was prioritized.</p> <p>Through a previous action of the Council, the project design was prepared by Maestes and Associates. Following completion of the design, Maestes estimated that the construction cost would be \$67,019.30.</p>

	<p>Two construction bids were received, ranging from \$79,833.95 and \$88,659.00. These amounts were both higher than the engineer's estimate, but the relatively small difference between them suggests the actual value of the work is slightly higher than the estimate.</p> <p>On the basis of the above, Staff recommends the Council receive the bids and award the construction contract to the low bidder, Lone Star Site Work, at a cost of \$79,833.95. Weather permitting, the construction should be complete by the end of this summer (2019).</p>
