SUMMARY	The construction plans for the Methodist Ambulatory Surgery Center show the proposed building conflicting with an existing three-phase overhead primary distribution line that is located within a utility easement. The owners of the property desire to have the electric line relocated and the easement abandoned. They have provided a design for the power line relocation and have signed a written agreement to reimburse the City for our costs (materials, labor and equipment) and to relocate the line. They are also in the process of providing a survey so they can provide a replacement easement to the City for the line in its new location. The total cost of the materials to be installed by City personnel is
	\$29,921.10. Since the cost of this purchase is greater than \$15,000, specific approval of the Council is required. Staff recommends the Council authorize the City Manager to proceed with this materials purchase.
