TYPE OF WORK: One 24" x 47.5" canopy sign which denotes Black Rifle Coffee at

the side wall of the building along San Antonio Avenue – the hanging sign is made of max metal with a digital printed face.

REQUEST: Request for approval for a Certificate of Appropriateness for a

wall sign.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of the proposed canopy sign. The

proposed sign conforms to the recommended Historic Design Guidelines in keeping the proposed colors to no more than four

and the proposed fonts to only two.

CASE COMMENTS: A canopy sign, which is perpendicular to a building face, shall not

exceed two-thirds (2/3) of the width of the canopy structure. The proposed sign is 4 feet in length and meets the requirement. The canopy in which the proposed canopy sign is to be installed under is 9.5 feet in length. The proposed sign meets the recommended Historic District Design Guidelines. As noted above, the sign is

within the ordinance size and type requirements.

This is one of three signs proposed which includes one canopy sign and two wall signs. The ordinance permits each establishment to request no more than three signs.
