Mike,

Attached is a map of the monitoring locations and data summaries sorted by location. I would reference the *E.coli* and Nutrient summary as these are the indicators we will primarily use to detect a change in water quality. I did include all data collected in case you need to reference it. There are no TCEQ nutrient criteria established for surface water. However, the nutrient levels are currently very low. Bacterial levels at the lake are also very low. We had a hit on Bacteria at Sparkling Springs (state 20830) but that's not unexpected since we had rainfall the day prior. All in all, after two monitoring events water quality at the lake is very good. I should have the July data in a few weeks.
