SUMMARY	The City of Boerne has had an Interlocal Agreement with the City of
	Fair Oaks Ranch for Animal Control Services, since 2000. Boerne really serves as the holding facility for Fair Oaks Ranch's animals that are picked up by their Animal Control Officer. After the legal holding period the animals are released to our facility and we proceed to find them homes. The contract is based on the number of animals brought in to our
	facility for a 12 month period ending in April, factoring in a percentage of the expense of operating our shelter, using our current year budget.
	Based on calculations, the amount due from the City of Fair Oaks Ranch is 13.346% of the operational costs of \$173,272.88 equaling \$23,125.39 or a monthly sum of \$1,927.12 over the period of this agreement. This is a 9.6% decrease over the previous year's expense. This is due to the decrease in animals that have been brought in and the turnover of possession to the City of Boerne.
	The City of Fair Oaks Ranch has been provided with the calculations. There is no change in the Interlocal (other than the cost) and should be taking it to their City Council in the near future.
