SUMMARY	In the 86 th Texas Legislative Session, House Bill 914 relating to the collection of bingo prize fees was passed. As part of this new bill, to be eligible to continue collecting bingo prize fees from any charitable bingo activity that occurs within the City limits, a municipal government must pass a Resolution to impose the prize fees and provide a copy to the Texas Lottery Commission by November 1, 2019. Although fees collected in the past have not been significant, we still would like to opt in to continuing the collection of bingo prize fees.
