SUMMARY	In 2006, during the construction of the Methodist Hospital Emergency Room and/or the adjacent multi-story medical facility, a utility easement was granted to the City of Boerne for installation and maintenance of an overhead primary electric distribution line serving the property and beyond. That easement was located within a property owned by Methodist Healthcare System of SA. Recently, City Staff was approached by representatives of Methodist Healthcare regarding the proposed construction of an Ambulatory Surgery Center on that site. That proposed facility was in conflict with the previously granted easement and the operational electric line contained within. As part of their construction of the new facility, Methodist designed and paid for the relocation of the electric distribution line and provided a replacement easement for the relocated line. Since the public has received fair compensation for its assets, Staff now recommends the Council authorize the abandonment of the previously existing easement.
