COST	The current light tower that is installed on the rescue truck is over 20 years old and has become undependable and an expensive maintenance item that is no longer cost effective to repair. The light tower is a necessity for night time operations at emergency scenes and is important for firefighter safety. Replacement light tower options have been explored and the Will-Burt LED Night Scan XL200 with dual tilt is similar to what is currently on the rescue truck as far as function and is being recommended to replace the current light tower. Three quotes have been received:  Arnold Fire Equipment - \$31,504.00  Precision Fire Apparatus - \$31,704.00  Will-Burt - \$25,683.50  Staff recommends approval of the purchase through Will-Burt for \$25,683.50.
