SUMMARY	The current fiscal year budget includes funding for purchase and installation of a replacement (1 of 4) submersible pump for the influent wet-well at the Wastewater Treatment and Recycling Center (WWTRC). The originally installed pumps from another manufacturer have been problematic from the time of initial installation. Three have already been replaced, two of which were emergency replacements after sudden failures. We have subsequently had positive operational experience with the three new pumps from Flyght, and budgeted for replacement of the final –in-service unit. Like our last replacement, this existing pump will be kept as a spare. Xylem Water Solutions is a sole-source supplier and installer of this proprietary equipment. A letter is attached attesting to that fact. The budget for this purchase was \$40,000.000. The proposed purchase price is less than the budgeted amount. Since the total cost of this purchase is greater than \$15,000, however, specific approval for the purchase by the Council is required per the City Charter. Staff recommends the Council authorize the City Manager to proceed.
