SUMMARY	In FY 18/19 we began the process of servicing and repairing the flood warning barricades throughout the City. We have seven locations, with a total of fourteen barricades (two at each crossing, one on each side of the low water crossing) that still need to be serviced and repaired.  These units are approximately fifteen years old and have never been serviced or repaired. The company who built the systems is no longer in business, so finding someone who would perform repairs, servicing and updating was challenging.  We located a local company, Progressive Emergency Products, who was willing to perform the servicing and repairs. In FY 18/19  Progressive Emergency Products repaired five barricades, and did good, quality work.
	In the FY 19/20 budget we have budgeted funds to service and repair additional units in the amount of \$23,000. Staff is recommending to allow Progressive Emergency Products to continue with the needed servicing and repairs on an additional seven barricades, not to exceed \$23,000. This will leave two barricades to be serviced and repaired in FY 20/21.
