DESCRIPTION	RECEIVE BIDS AND AWARD CONTRACT FOR ESSER ROAD ELECTRICAL FEEDER UPGRADE PROJECT AND CONSIDER RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R171; A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND MANAGE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOERNE AND _____ FOR THE ESSER/ADLER ROAD ELECTRICAL FEEDER UPGRADE PROJECT.
STAFF'S RECOMMENDED ACTION (be specific)	Receive bids and Approve Resolution No. 2019-R171; awarding the construction contract for the Esser/Adler Road Electric Distribution Feeder Upgrade project to Grays Power Supply in the amount of \$345,855.97.

SUMMARY	<p>For a number of years, we have been working to install, upgrade and/or replace existing electric distribution feeder lines extending between our two power supply substations for system reliability and redundancy purposes. Last fiscal year's budget ('18-'19) included funding for a remaining portion of the work, a feeder extending along Esser Road and Adler Road from the Boerne Substation on Plant Street.</p> <p>Due to project re-prioritization, we were able to complete design but not in time to construct the project before the end of the fiscal year. We instead carried over \$350,000 in funding for the work to the current fiscal year.</p> <p>The project was bid publicly in October, and two bids were received ranging from \$345,855.97 to \$434,258.44. The low bidder was Grays Power Supply. We have not worked with that particular contractor before. But our consultant, Schneider Engineering, reviewed their qualifications and recommends award to that contractor. A copy of the Schneider recommendation letter is attached.</p> <p>On the basis of the above, Staff recommends that Council receive the bids and award the construction project to Grays Power Supply.</p>
