SUMMARY	<p>In July Council authorized the hiring of Troy Dorman with Halff Associates to assist in making revisions to our current ordinances and then continuing to work with Carissa Cox with Mosaic to carry those revisions over to the new UDC.</p> <p>Troy Dorman and Josh Logan with Halff Associates have worked closely with staff, various members of the community, our UDC consultant and the steering committee to determine the best direction for the City. Our call is to determine an equitable balance in how to develop respectfully and thoughtfully in and around sensitive environmental areas within the city limits and the ETJ.</p> <p>Mr. Dorman will present the proposed changes to the Subdivision Ordinance, Code of Ordinances (flood plain) and the Zoning Ordinance. He will continue to work with us as we make amendments to the ordinances through the UDC to reinforce the changes we are making now. Council will consider these items at their December 10th meeting.</p>
