DESCRIPTION

APPROVE THE PURCHASE/INSTALLATION OF STORAGE MEZZANINE FLOORING AND SHELVING FOR THE UTILITIES WAREHOUSE.

SUMMARY

Inside the utilities warehouse on Esser Road is an access-controlled "cage" in which we store our smaller newly purchased materials used for maintenance and construction of utility infrastructure. This facility has helped us organize our inventories and provided additional security for these valuable items.



When the cage was installed, the ends of the second floor mezzanine were left open to accommodate the type of roll-up doors that were

| | previously in place. We are in need of additional space due to increases in materials that we must keep on-hand. The current fiscal year budget includes \$30,000 funding for the purchase and installation of additional flooring and shelving to complete the second level mezzanine area. We propose to purchase the additional materials from the same supplier from which we purchased the original enclosure to help ensure compatibility of the |
