SUMMARY	Staff has been directed by Council to expeditiously prepare the updates. Stream Corridors and setbacks are currently defined in the Zoning Ordinance, but the Zoning Ordinance may only be applied in the city limits. We plan to relocate this section of the Zoning Ordinance over to the Subdivision regulations so that it may be applied to development in the city limits and in the ETJ. At this time we are removing these definitions from the Zoning Ordinance so they may be included in the Subdivision Ordinance and then may be applied uniformly in the city limits and in the ETJ. In January, Council will consider the final piece to the puzzle by incorporating the entirety of Integrated Stormwater Management into the Subdivision Ordinance and Code of Ordinances. Low Impact Development and Stream Setbacks will be part of that amendment.
