5 YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

- Finance requested information from Departments on capital projects planned and personnel needed over the next 5 years
- A Financial Forecast will be developed to determine the availability of funding for capital projects and new personnel
- Future costs of maintenance for new facilities will be included in the Financial Forecast
- Not all of the projects listed will have available funding
- Will be used to begin FY 2020 2021 Budget
