SUMMARY	<p>What we thought would initially be some “tweaks” to our current ordinances have turned into much broader and impactful edits. This ordinance amendment deserves more thoughtful consideration and time to study. The most recent revisions have not been reviewed or vetted by the entire steering committee. We plan to hold another steering committee meeting on December 12th to “stress test” the proposed revisions using real world scenarios and then will follow up with revision review on December 17th. There are no large developments that are imminent and taking a few more weeks to allow the entire steering committee to weigh in on the revisions and receive feedback is imperative.</p>
