In addition, we have already submitted this report to the State of Texas.</p> <p>Over the past several years we have also included Statistical Data in this report as well as our Uniform Crime Report (UCR) that is sent to the FBI. In 2016, the police department transitioned to the National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS) that is replacing the UCR format. This is being done all across the United States in an attempt to gain more information from the reports rather than just numerical numbers that have been reported under the UCR format.</p> <p>I hope everyone finds this report to be informational as to the crimes occurring as well as the challenges we will face in the future and understand that our crime for 2019 was lower than in the past two years.
