SUMMARY	<p>Previously the City of Boerne partnered with the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) to prepare a pedestrian & bicycle recommendation for the City. This study recommended key pedestrian facilities to help connect more of the City together and link neighborhoods to the Number 9 Trail.</p> <p>In April of 2018, based upon these initial AAMPO suggestions, the previous City Council, initiated a 3-year phase plan with potential sidewalk improvement projects and budgets for the phases.</p> <p>Last year 3 projects were constructed; West San Antonio from the Cibolo Creek Bridge to Oak Lane, Bentwood sidewalk bridge, and the Blanco sidewalk tree “bridge”. In addition, the city funded the oversizing of the Herff Farm sidewalk from 5’ to 8’ wide in conjunction with the Legacy at Cibolo project.</p> <p>There is a total design/construction budget of \$515,000 during the current fiscal year and \$415,000 for the third and final year.</p> <p>At the workshop on February 11, 2020, Staff will review the previously identified sidewalk improvement projects in order to confirm or modify the council’s priorities.</p>
