Mr. Rick Schroder did not attend the forum.

Also included in the forum were candidates for the BISD School Board Place 7, Rich Sena and Mike Hogan.

Mr. Granados instructed the candidates of the process for the forum. Each candidate was given two minutes to present their personal background.

Each candidate was presented with five questions prior the forum. Each to given candidate was three minutes to respond to each question, alternating between candidates.

4. 2017-312 QUESTIONS ADDRESSED TO CANDIDATES

Following is a list of potential City-related topics that may be asked and answered by the candidates.

- 1. Challenges and opportunities facing the Boerne business community
- 2. Past performance and future direction of City services and infrastructure
- 3. Land use, planning and zoning, and the City's Master Plan
- 4. Mobility and thoroughfare planning
- 5. Preserving and enhancing quality of life

The questions were answered by each City candidate according to their political views.

The BISD candidates received a different set of questions relating to the school district.

Mr. Granados then offered each candidate a two minute opportunity for closing remarks.

5. <u>2017-313</u> INFORMAL QUESTION PERIOD BETWEEN ALL CANDIDATES AND ATTENDEES

Topics may include, but are not limited to, the above issues plus zoning, annexation, parks, trails and the Parks Master Plan process, parking, City finances, utilities, public safety and/or

economic development matters.

The audience was provided an index card in advance of the forum, for the opportunity to ask questions to a candidate.

Questions asked audience included that were by the topics of growth, affordable relationship with housing, zoning, Kendall County, crime, parking, Certificate of Obligations v. Bonds, maintaining streets, traffic, and property development.
