7-0.**

ACTION ITEMS:

1. [2019-117](#) Request for approval for a Certificate of Appropriateness for a 48”
x 96” wall sign located at 455 S. Main Street, Suite 3 (Forever Fit
Boerne). Take necessary action.

Ms. Susana Ramos explained the request for a 48" X 96" wall sign. The wall sign will be on the side of the building and will be digitally produced on max metal. The owner agreed to reduce the font to two styles. Staff is supportive and recommends approval.

Ms. Lisa Sallick, owner of the business, explained the design of the sign and stated there will only be two fonts and will adjust the bottom leaf color to only be Kelly Green.

COMMISSIONER NICHOLS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE A CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS FOR A 48" X 96" WALL SIGN LOCATED AT 455 S. MAIN STREET, SUITE 3 (FOREVER FIT BOERNE), WITH THE CONDITION THE FONTS ARE REDUCED TO TWO STYLES AND THE COLOR SELECTION OF THE BOTTOM SHADOW OF THE LEAF IS CHANGED TO ONLY KELLY GREEN. COMMISSIONER NEWY SECONDED THE MOTION. THE MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

2. [2019-118](#) Request for approval for a Building permit for a demolition of a structure located at 248 N. Main Street (Dr. Tony Dacy, DDS). Take necessary action.

Item requested was withdrawn.

3. [2019-119](#) Request for approval for a Certificate of Appropriateness for exterior color selection for a metal roof and downspout/collector box located at 282 N. Main Street (Boerne Visitor's Center). Take necessary action.

Ms. Susana Ramos explained the request for a Certificate of Appropriateness for exterior color selection for a roof and downspout/collector box.

Mr. Paul Barwick, Director of Special Projects, stated the color request for the roof will be a medium bronze color. The color of the downspout/collector box will be also be metal and in the same medium bronze color.

COMMISSIONER KERR MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE A CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS FOR EXTERIOR COLOR SELECTION FOR A METAL ROOF AND DOWNSPOUT/COLLECTOR BOX LOCATED AT 282 N. MAIN STREET (BOERNE VISITOR'S CENTER). COMMISSIONER CUEVAS SECONDED THE MOTION. THE MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

- 4. [2019-120](#) Request for approval for a Certificate of Appropriateness for lighting located at 282 N. Main Street (Boerne Visitor’s Center).
Take necessary action.

Mr. Paul Barwick explained the Certificate of Appropriateness for lighting. The color of the metal will match the previously approved wall sconces. There will be eight fixtures total around both the front and the rear of the building. The lighting will be LED with a lower rating to provide a warmer looking light and will be dark sky compliant.

COMMISSIONER KERR MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE A CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS FOR LIGHTING LOCATED AT 282 N. MAIN STREET (BOERNE VISITOR’S CENTER). COMMISSIONER BERGMANN SECONDED THE MOTION. THE MOTION CARRIED 7-0.
