RECOMMENDED VERBIAGE FOR CITY COUNCIL ACTION:

Approve Or Deny Resolution No. 2017-R63; A Resolution Of The City Of Boerne Authorizing The Use Of Real Property Owned By The City Of Boerne And Designated As Parkland; Confirming Proper Notice Of An Official Determination To Use The Real Property; Conducting A Public Hearing Prior To Approval Of Use Of Said Property Finding That There Is No Feasible And Prudent Alternative To The Use And That The Project Includes All Reasonable Planning To Minimize Harm To The Remaining Parkland; And Authorizing The City Manager To Engage In Further Negotiations Regarding The Use Of Park Property.
